

Welcombe Golf Club & Spa Membership Terms and Conditions

GENERAL

Golf Club (the Club) & Spa (the Spa)

The Club & the Spa are operated by Menzies Hotels Operating Limited (the Company). It is a condition of acceptance of membership that the member agrees to pay the joining fee where applicable and agrees to be bound by the Membership Terms and Conditions.

Payments

Payments can be made in full by cheque, cash, credit card or by monthly direct debit. The member agrees to maintain membership for the 12 months commencing on the date the membership application is approved. Unless cancelled in writing, the member will continue membership for the next 12 months and every anniversary thereafter (the Membership Period). In the event of the member terminating membership the member is liable to pay for any outstanding subscriptions that may be due within the Membership Period.

All joining fees, subscriptions, levy and other receipts shall become the property of the Company. If membership is cancelled or terminated the Company will make no refund in respect of any monies paid.

Termination

The membership of any member may be terminated, not withstanding the Company's entitlement to receive payment for outstanding subscriptions that may be due in the current Membership Period.

BY THE COMPANY

Without notice in the event of such member committing a serious or repeated breach of the Club or the Spa's Terms and Conditions as may be amended from time to time.

By notice in writing if any payment owing to the Club or the Spa by the member remains unpaid 30 days after the due date for payment.

Upon not less than 30 days' notice in writing if the Company believes that the membership is not suitable for continued membership of the Club or the Spa. There is no obligation on the Company to give a reason for such a decision.

BY THE MEMBER

Membership is for a 12 month period and termination of the membership must be given in writing to the Club or the Spa at least 30 days prior to the annual renewal date. Change of address, telephone number or bank details if payment is made by direct debit should be given in writing to the Club or the Spa.

Liability

The Company accepts no liability whatsoever for accident, injury, misadventure. All members and their guests and visitors are responsible for making their own insurance arrangements in respect of injury suffered or caused by them, or caused to them by any third party.

The Company does not accept liability or responsibility for the loss of or damage to property or motor vehicles belonging to any member, their guests and visitors.

Each member is responsible for making their guests aware of the Club's and the Spa's Terms and Conditions, golf course etiquette and ensuring that their guests are aware of their own insurance liability.

Any dispute or difference which may arise in regard to the interpretation of these rules shall be determined by the Company whose decision shall be final. The Company reserves the right to vary, revoke or add to these Terms and Conditions from time to time at its absolute discretion. The failure of the Company to enforce any of its rights at any time for any period shall not be construed as a waiver of such rights.

GOLF

Membership

The Company reserves the right to reject any application for membership of the Club without giving any reason. The membership is personal to the member at the location for which membership is granted and cannot be transferred.

The Company may assign the benefit of this agreement to any person, firm or company at any time without notice to the member.

The club offers the following types of membership –

Individual Membership

Available to any individual of at least 18 years of age. An individual member is entitled to full use of the course at any time subject to availability of tee times.

Joint Membership

Available to couples of at least 18 years of age who must be domiciled at the same address. Joint members are each entitled to full use of the course at any time subject to availability of tee times.

Corporate Membership

Corporate membership is available as a four ball only. Corporate membership is in the name of the company or organisation and can be used by any authorised person producing a membership card to use on the course at any time subject to the availability of tee times. The Company will issue four membership cards; the security of the membership cards is the responsibility of the company or organisation. Three guests may play with the authorised person at no charge on a four ball corporate membership. Only one corporate membership card holder may be on the course at any one time. Four ball corporate members are entitled to £1,000 discount on one golf day for a minimum of 24 golfers booked at the published price. This discount may be applied once at any of the Company's Golf Clubs. Authorised Corporate membership card holders are eligible to play in Club competitions. Guests of corporate members are not permitted to play in any competitions. On these occasions the authorised corporate membership card holders are not permitted to be accompanied by any guests.

Junior Membership

Junior membership is available to children aged between 11 and 17 years of age at the time of joining who may have full use of the course subject to availability of tee times.

Fees

An initial joining fee (Junior and corporate membership excepted) and a membership charge shall be payable for each class of membership which will be reviewed annually.

Admission

Every member shall be issued with a membership card and golf bag tag. Members must present their card on each visit to the Club and display their golf tag when out on the golf course. A charge will be made for replacement of lost membership cards and tags.

Members' Guests & Visitors

Members' guests must always be accompanied by the member introducing them who will then be responsible for the guest's actions and safety whilst playing golf or within the Clubs premises.

A member may introduce up to three guests, who will be charged the members guest rate as appropriate. The same guest however may not play more than twice in any one calendar month whether the introduction is by one member or by different members. There are limited times when Visitors (not guests of full members) are permitted to play. Visitors are generally not permitted to play at weekends.

The Club may refuse any guest from using the Club without giving any reason. The members guest and Visitor charges together with admission hours may vary from time to time.

Dress

Appropriate dress must be worn at all times within the Club and on the course, which complies with the 'Dress Code', which is displayed on the golf shop notice board. It is a condition of the Club that soft spikes are to be worn.

Course Closure

There will be occasions when play is not possible due to corporate or society days taking place. On such occasions no refunds or allowances will be made against memberships.

Reservations

Individual members may only reserve a tee time 14 days in advance. Corporate members may reserve tee times 21 days in advance except on Saturdays and Sundays and bank holidays, which can only be reserved 14 days in advance. All bookings of tee times are strictly subject to availability.

All members must report to the clubhouse before commencing play in order that their individual identity card can be verified and a green ticket issued. Without the same the member and their guests will not be permitted to play.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be advised to the clubhouse no later than 24 hours before the tee time reserved. The Company reserves the right to charge for tee times booked and not utilised by members, including any reduction in numbers in a tee time.

There will be occasions at busy times when single players cannot book tee times.

Conduct of Members

Members and guests are expected to behave in a manner appropriate for a high quality golf club and respect the etiquette of golf. Golfers are under a duty to take reasonable care to avoid causing injury to other golfers and members of the public. Golfers may be liable for any damage caused to surrounding property. Any incident of injury or damage caused must be reported to the clubhouse immediately.

The clubhouse is available to the use of members, their guests and visitors. The lockers in the respective changing areas will be cleared each evening. Members are not permitted to store clubs or other items overnight.

Mobile phones are not to be used on the course, but may be used in the clubhouse, respecting of course other members and guests.

The driving range is only available to members, their guests if playing a round of golf, visitors playing golf, hotel residents and pupils of the golf professional.

Handicap

Any member who wishes to receive a handicap must play at least three rounds of eighteen holes with another golfer with an official handicap and submit the completed cards together with the accompanying golfers handicap certificate to the PGA golf professional in the clubhouse.

Other

The hours during which the Club is open for use by members are shown to members on joining. They may change from time to time or for bank holidays, maintenance or ground works. The Company will use its reasonable endeavours to ensure that the golf course is available for use by members during such time as the golf course may be open, but there may be occasions when the course may not be available for reasons beyond the control of the Company, occasions when it is considered dangerous to play or when the weather is such that damage could be incurred to the course.

SPA

Membership

The membership is personal to the member and cannot be transferred. Any member who allows their card to be used by a non-member will have their membership terminated.

Individual membership is available to individuals of at least 18 years of age. Joint membership is available to couples of at least 18 years of age who must be domiciled at the same address.

Conduct

Members will at all times behave in an orderly and sensible manner. They will also be responsible for the good conduct of their guests whilst using the Spa.

Any incident of injury or damage must be reported to the Spa reception immediately.

The Spa has a no smoking policy and we ask that all mobile phones, laptops and pagers are turned off prior to entering the complex.

Children

Children under the age of 16 are only permitted access to the swimming pool area within the Spa complex and at all times must be accompanied by an adult. Children under 16 are not permitted to use the pool during certain hours as displayed at the Spa reception. Subject to the relevant entrance fee children of members can use the swimming pool during the permitted hours. Children under 16 are strictly not allowed in the gymnasium, thermal rooms or treatment rooms.

Spa Treatments

All treatments need to be booked in advance and we recommend you arrive at least 15 minutes before your treatment is due to start. Late arrival may mean your treatment time is reduced or unable to be honoured. Individual treatments cancelled less than 24 hours in advance will incur a 50% cancellation charge and less than six hours will incur a 100% cancellation charge.
